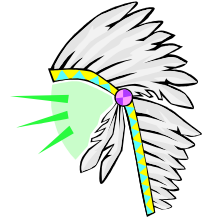




American Indian Design Challenge

Powhatan - Eastern Woodlands ♦ Sioux - Plains ♦ Pueblo - Southwest



Background: We have been studying American Indians. We learned about where and how they lived, and about the transportation they used. Now we need to share what we've learned.

Design Challenge:

Design and construct a pop up card that will focus on **ONE** of the three tribes of American Indians that we studied. You will share your card with the class like an oral report.

Criteria:

Your card must

- ❑ have at least one pop up.
- ❑ have one movable part (operated by a lever).
- ❑ include the home, main occupation, and transportation of the American Indian tribe you choose.
- ❑ be no larger than this sheet of paper.
- ❑ be colorful and neat.

Materials:

- construction paper
- scrap box material
- glue
- 1 brass paper fastener

Tools:

- scissors
- markers (for writing only)
- colored pencils
- ruler
- push pin
