



Good Speech at Home

Background:

In speech class we have been learning the importance of using correct speech sounds everywhere we go and every time we speak. You are using your new speech sounds in the speech room. Now it is time to remember to use your good speech sounds at home, too!

Design Challenge:

Design and create a card that you can keep at home that will help you remember to use your good speech sounds there.

Criteria:

Your card must:

- ❑ have at least one pop-up.
- ❑ have one lever-operated part that moves.
- ❑ have your speech sound written on it somewhere.
- ❑ fit into a 9" by 12" envelope.
- ❑ include a reminder to use good speech.

Materials: *You may use any of the listed items. You do not have to use all of them.*

- Construction paper
- Copy paper
- No more than 2 brass paper fasteners
- Aluminum foil
- Tissue paper

Tools: *You may use any of the listed tools. You do not have to use all of them.*

- Scissors
- Pencil
- Colored pencils
- Crayons
- Glue stick
- Markers
- Hole punch
- Ruler
