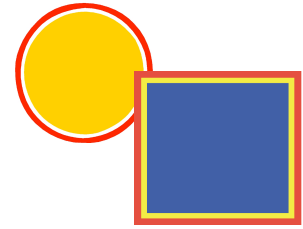


Shapes in Our World



Background :

Criteria:

Your picture must:

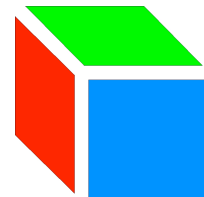
- use circles, squares, rectangles, and triangles.
- use only the shapes provided.
- use at least three different colors.
- have at least one moving part.
- have no more than 15 shapes in all.
- have your first and last name on it.

Materials: *You may use all or some of the materials listed below.*

- pre-cut shapes
- glue
- paper for the background
- paper fasteners/brads

Tools: *You may only use the tools listed below.*

- pencil for writing your name



Time frame: 2 or 3 class periods
