



# Virginia History Lives Invitation



## Design Brief

### Background:

Throughout the school year, fourth grade students have been studying many Virginians who played an important role in the history of our country. The students will choose a famous Virginian to research and will write and memorize a one-minute speech, which they will recite while dressed up as that person at our annual Virginia History Lives Museum.

### Design Challenge:

You will design and create an invitation to be given to your parents, inviting them to attend the annual Virginia History Lives Museum put on by the Fourth Grade students.

### Criteria:

Your invitation must

- Have one pop-up.
- Have one lever operated moving part.
- Include the date, time, and location of the museum.
- Have at least three colors on it.
- Include your name.
- Include the name of the Virginian you will be representing at the museum.

### Materials:

- One sheet of construction paper for invitation background
- A variety of colored construction paper
- Brass fasteners
- Glue

### Tools:

- Scissors
- Ruler
- Crayons
- Markers
- Pencil

**Time Frame:** One class period.
