Challenge:

Design and create a triorama that compares and contrasts the two civilizations. Use your knowledge of ancient China and Egypt to help you in designing and building your triorama.

Criteria:

Your triorama must –

- be able to stand on its own.
- have one or more moving parts.
- show 3 characteristics from each civilization. Choose from the following–
 - 1 landform from each.
 - 1 architectural feature from each.
 - 1 invention from each.
 - 1 characteristic of your choice from each.
- have a title and your name.
- be decorated with appropriate scenery.
