- include one or more moving parts on each page.
- have a cover with a title.

Materials:

Use what you want. You do not have to use it all.

- construction paper
- brads
- pipe cleaners
- craft sticks
- scrap paper
- glue
- flattened food boxes
- yarn
- twist ties

Tools:

- scissors
- ruler
- hole punch
- pushpin paper drill
- crayons
