Criteria:

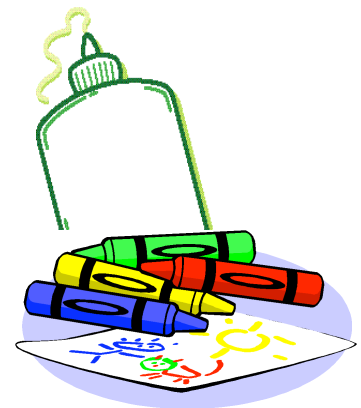
Your card must

- be edited for spelling and capital letters.
